From Hiroshima Station to Higashi Hiroshima Campus

Please take a train on the Sanyohonsen line bound for Saijo, Shiraichi and Okayama. The train usually departs from platform 5, but occasionally will depart from other platforms. It will take approximately 30 minutes by express and 40 minutes by ordinary train. Please get off the train at Saijo Station.

From Hiroshima Bus Center to Higashi Hiroshima Campus

There is a highway bus service approximately every hour between 6:30 a.m. and 8 p.m. from the Bus Center to the Higashi Hiroshima Campus. Buses depart from platform 1. It will take approximately 1 hour. Please refer to the campus map to determine which bus stop to get off at when you reach the Higashi Hiroshima Campus. For more information in Japanese, please refer to the Chugoku JR Bus website.

Participants:

- International (Foreign) students in Chugoku region
 (Not necessary to be the student in the field of geotechnical engineering).
- 2) Japanese students studying geotechnical engineering in Chugoku region.
- 3) Young engineers in the organization belong to JGS Chugoku blanch.
- Fee : Basically free. (¥3,000, the stipend for the party is necessary)

 For international (Foreign) students, the travelling stipend for express bus between Hiroshima University and each are will be supported. (Note, these foreign students are requested to make a brief presentation in the program)
- Contents of the event : Group works related with geotechnical engineering.

 Please bring (English) textbooks for geotechical engineering or soil mechanics.
- Maximum number of participants: 24

(The balance in the numbers of international students, Japanese students and young engineers will be considered)

Deadline for application: July 31st, 2013.
